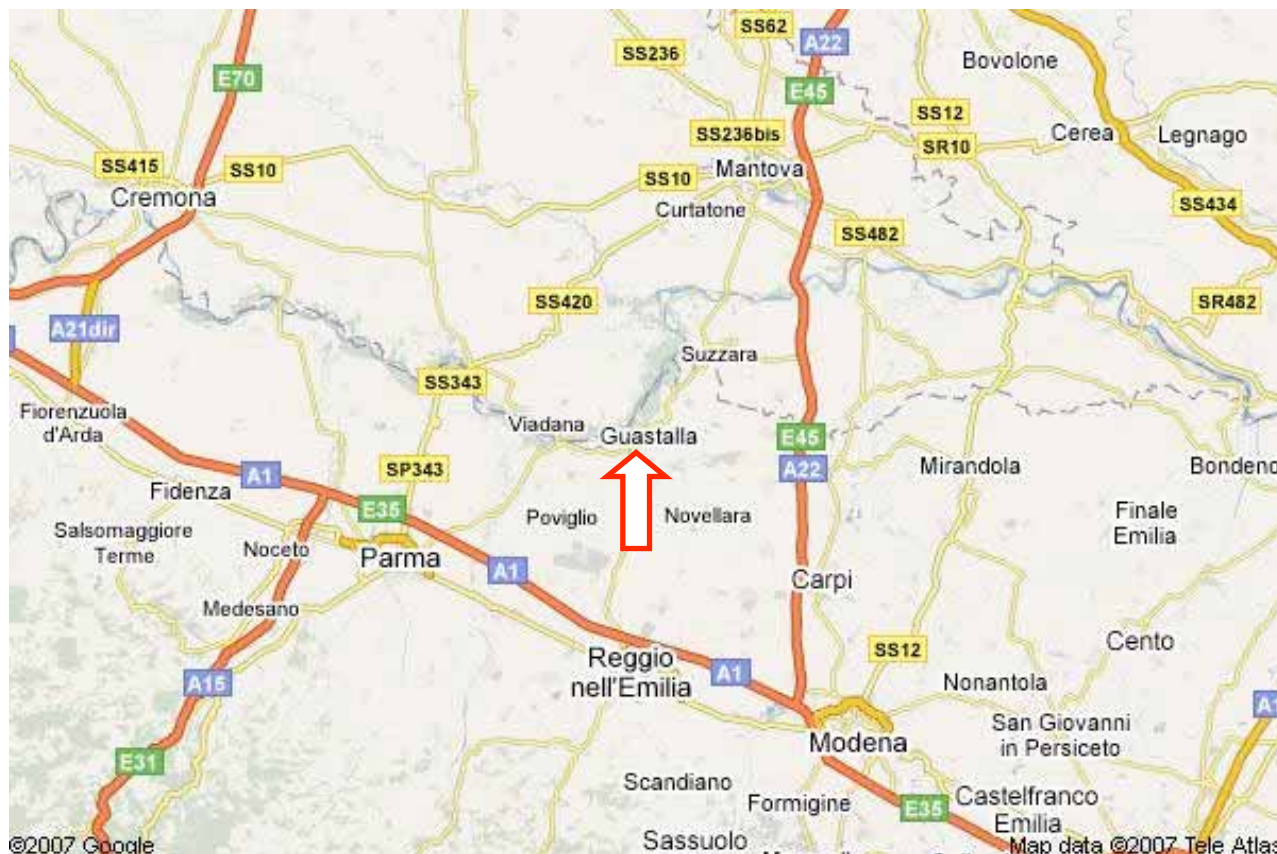
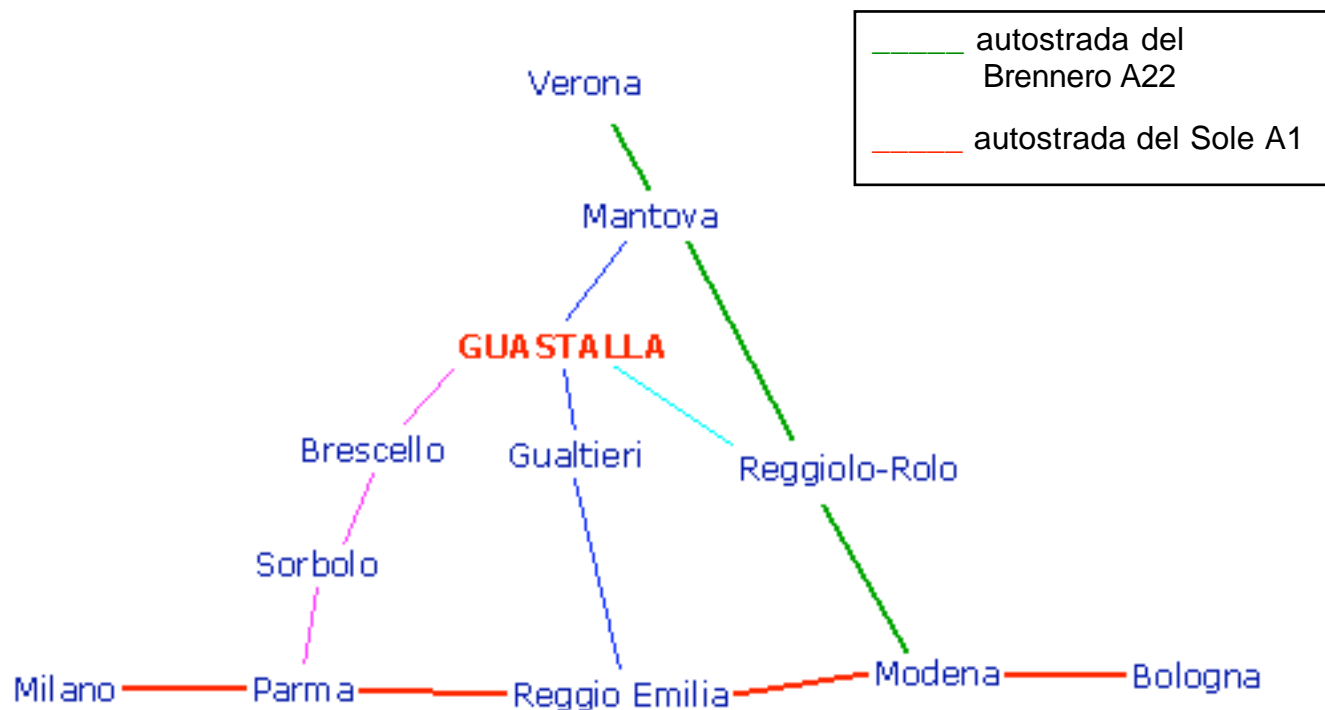

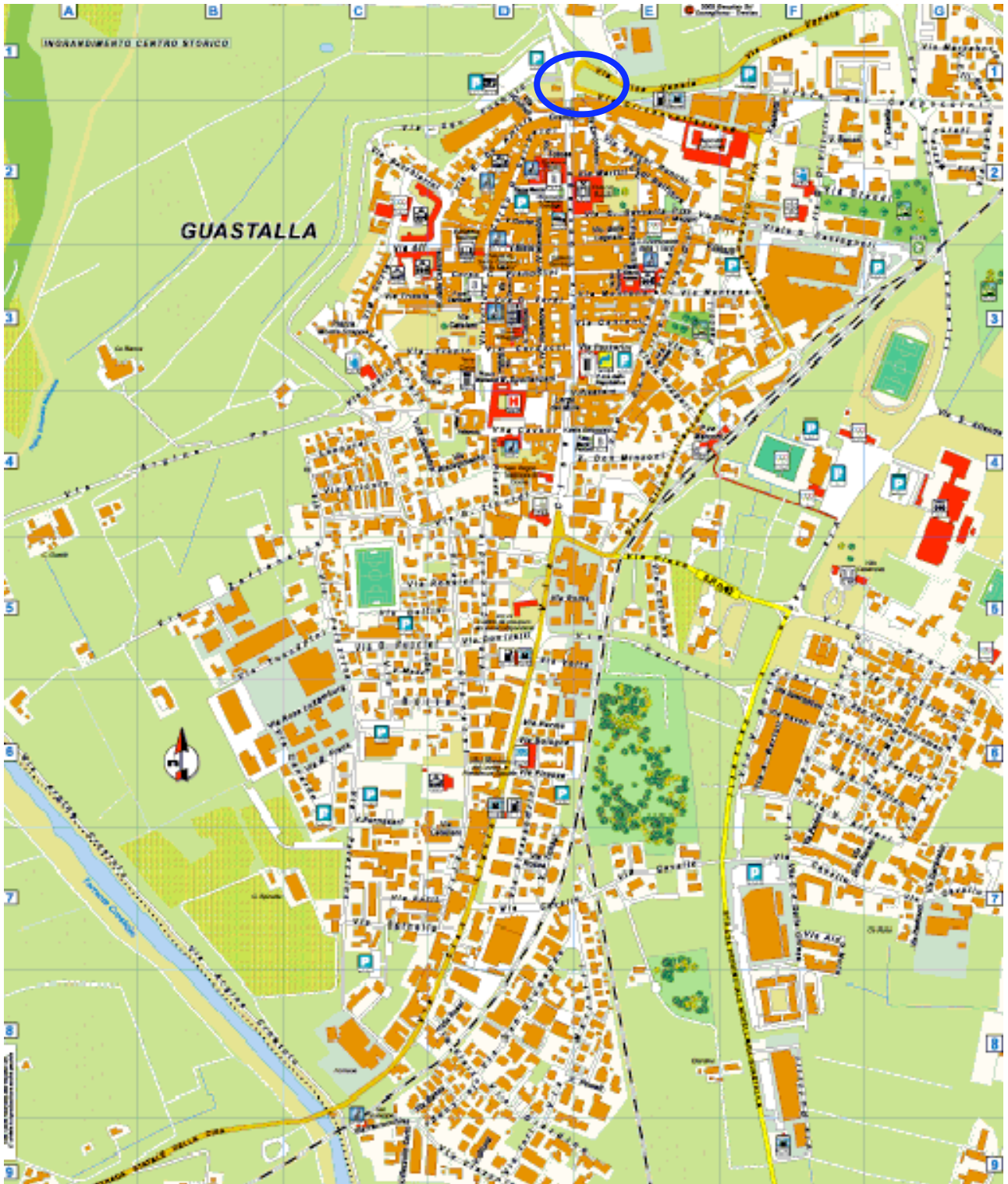

Guastalla is in Northern Italy in the centre of the Po plain between Milano, Bologna and Verona, in the triangle of Parma-Modena-Mantova. Access by the Brenner Motorway and the Autostrada del Sole. Train connection to Reggio Emilia.
